TWY C9 and C10 names, TWY D3, Hot Spot 3, Pad B and Terminal B stands incorrect

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2310, effective 05 October 2023, contains incorrect data for Kansas City Intl; Kansas City, Missouri (KMCI). NFDD 179, effective 30 September 2023, introduced several changes, which are not reflected in cycle 2310 data:

- TWY C9 changed to C10
- TWY L changed to C9 (between TWY C and D)
- Removed Pad B
- Removed TWY L (between TWY D and S3)
- Added TWY D3 (between TWY D and L1)
- Revised Hot Spot 3
- Removed Terminal B Stands
