King Fahd Intl (OEDF) Cycle 2401 and 2402

TWYs B, C, C1 status incorrect.

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2401 (effective 25 January 2024) and cycle 2402 (effective 22 February 2024) contain incorrect data for King Fahd Intl; Dammam, Saudi Arabia (OEDF). Saudi Arabia AIP SUP 03/24, effective 05 February 2024, replacing AIP SUP 24/23, effective 26 November 2023, introduced "Phase-1 (Zone 3) in the Rehabilitation Project of West RWY 16R/34L and Taxiways" was received after 2401 and 2402 AIRAC cycles data processing due dates, therefore the following changes, valid from 06 February 2024, are not reflected in cycles 2401 and 2402 data:

- TWY B (south of TWY C2) is open
- TWYs C, C1 are open
