Runway 07/25 status incorrect

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2302 (effective 23 February 2023) and cycle 2303 (effective 23 March 2023) contain incorrect data for Taif Intl; Taif, Saudi Arabia (OETF). Saudi Arabia AIP SUP 05/23, effective 09 March 2023, introducing “SWY and RESA 07: Rehabilitation for Stopway and extension of the Runway End Safety Area (Side RWY 07)”, was received after 2302 and 2303 AIRAC cycles data processing due dates, therefore following changes (effective 09 March 2023) are not reflected in cycle 2302 and 2303 data:

- **RWY 07/25 is closed**
