To mitigate FMS memory limitations, Universal Avionics removed all VFR Reporting Points in Europe beginning in Cycle 2303, effective 23 March 2023. These waypoints are typically used for VFR flight near airports.

These waypoints may be utilized by creating pilot-defined waypoints in the FMS. For more information, reference the Pilot Data section in the applicable Universal Avionics UNS-1 Operator's Manual.

The Europe VFR reporting points will continue to be excluded until a resolution can be implemented.
